ABOUT IHDS:

The Indian Human Development Survey (IHDS) is a nationally representative, longitudinal panel survey conducted by NCAER, the University of Maryland, Indiana University, and the University of Michigan. It is the only large-scale panel dataset in India encompassing over 42,000 households across rural and urban areas. IHDS-1 (2005–06) and IHDS-2 (2011–12) achieved an 85% re-interview rate, with IHDS-3 slated for release in 2025. The survey collects data on education, caste, gender relations, health, and infrastructure, enabling interdisciplinary analyses. IHDS offers critical insights into the social and economic transformations shaping India's development over the past two decades.

Day 1: Introduction of IHDS data and its structure: Familiarization with STATA analysis software and its basic features

Day 2: Hands-on experience with exercises using IHDS in line with requirements of scientific journal articles
