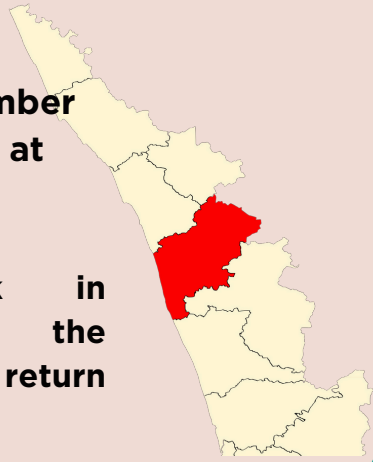

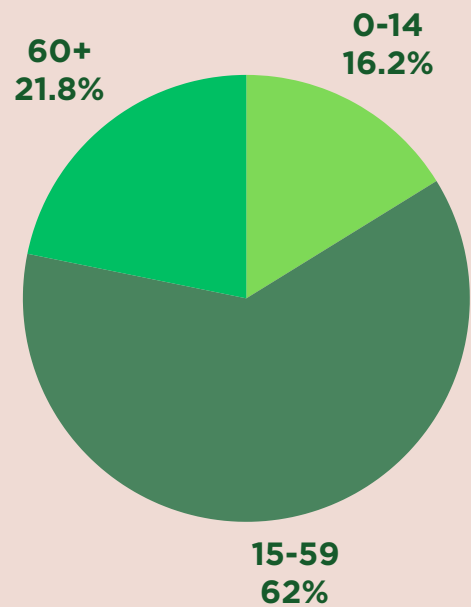
MALAPPURAM

AGE GROUP DISTRIBUTION OF THE POPULATION

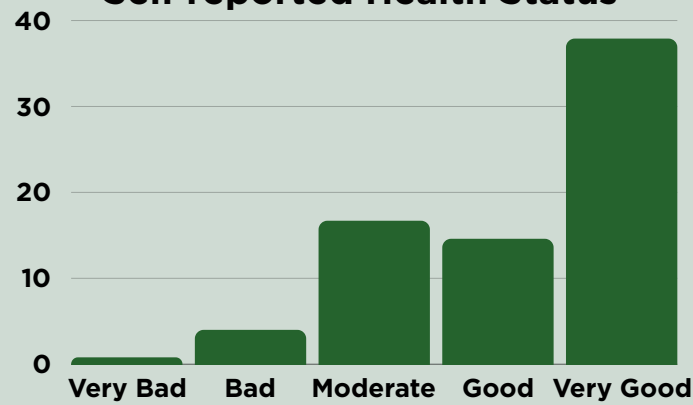

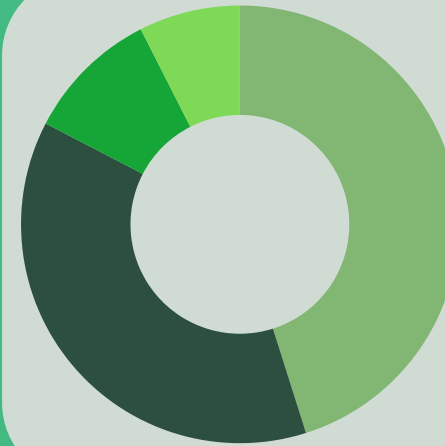

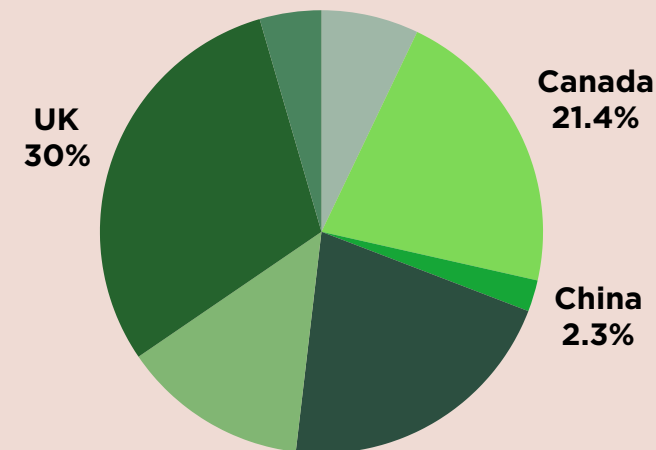

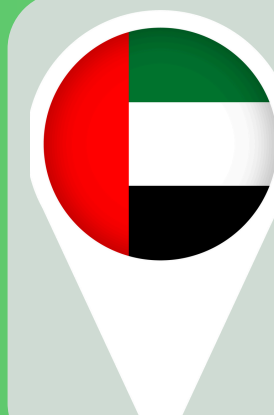

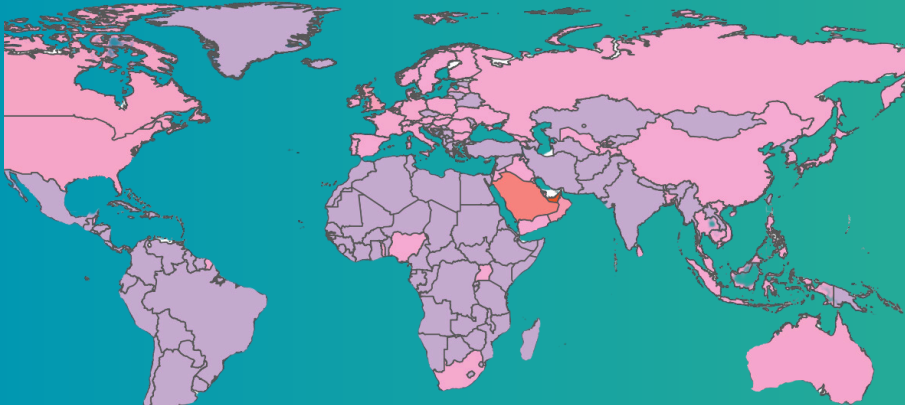
