PRE-CONFERENCE WORKSHOP

Quantitative Techniques and Analysis in Health Research



Wednesday, 5th August

This workshop equips participants with the skills to manage, analyse, and interpret large scale national survey datasets using Stata. Focusing on the National Sample Survey (NSS) data (Rounds 71st (2014) and 75th (2017-18)) on health consumption in India. Participants will engage in both conceptual discussions and hands-on exercises. The workshop emphasizes data construction, descriptive and inferential analysis, and the use of statistical methods in socio-economic and policy research. Learners will gain both theoretical grounding and practical expertise in applying quantitative techniques to real-world data for evidence-based research.

This offline workshop offers step-by-step training on PLFS data handling using STATA – from understanding survey structure and preparing dictionary files to data extraction, merging, and weight generation. Participants will also learn to construct key labour market indicators such as the labour force participation rate, workforce participation, and unemployment rates, and to validate labour market estimates using official reports. Ideal for students, researchers, and data practitioners looking to build practical, policy-relevant skills.
